



Mylan Announces Tentative Approval for Finasteride Tablets USP, 5mg

Finasteride Tablets are the AB-rated generic equivalent of Merck's Proscar[®] Tablets, 5 mg, which had annual U.S. sales of approximately \$390 million as of December 31, 2005, according to IMS Health.
